2. The decision of the judge is final, and no correspondence or communication may be entered into in this regard between parents/teachers/competitors and judge.
3. Dancer's age shall be as at 18 April 2026.
4. Any change in grading after completion of this entry form must be immediately communicated to the Competition Organiser.
5. The organisers are not responsible for any injuries, or loss incurred on the day of the competition.
6. The Competition Organiser reserves the right to cancel/combine age groups according to entries received, as per RSOBHD rules.
